What is Home Link

Home Link is a respite scheme where host families provide short periods of care in their home. Breaks can be anything from a few hours during the day to a few days a month and could include overnight stays, weekends, short breaks or holidays.

People from all walks of life and experience are welcome to apply to become Home Link host families and previous experience of caring for a person with an intellectual disability and/or autism is not necessary, as full training and ongoing support will be provided. Personal qualities and a genuine desire to share in the care of a child or adult with an intellectual disability and/or autism are much more important than formal qualifications and experience.

Benefits of Home Link

- Provides a break to the families of clients.
- Huge positive benefits to clients - new friendships, promotion of independence, building of social skills and broadening of horizons and experiences.
- Home Link host families can learn more about people with intellectual disability and autism while caring and sharing their own home and family life.
